The Peace Education Project

The Peace Education Project works with partner institutions to improve their knowledge and skills in the context of conflict transformation. We want to support the Battambang community in being able to analyze local conflicts and reflect on their behaviour and attitudes to reduce stereotypes and discrimination.

Together with our partner Preah Sihanouk Raja Buddhist University, Battambang Branch (SBUBB), we develop and implement short courses on conflict transformation. We educate trainers to teach and share their learned skills and knowledge with students and the community.
